- 1. That which supports, unites, sustains and harmonises the individual and the society is Dharma. Example love.

 That which divides and causes conflict is adharma e.g. hate.
- 2. The inherent nature of a thing without which that thing cannot exist is its essential dharma e.g. heat of fire. To abide in our true nature of Sat-Chit-Ananda is the highest dharma.
- 3. Following laws of nature and those that govern society is dharma.
- 4. Material prosperity with spiritual growth is dharma. Prosperity without spiritual growth is adharma.
