


- 4 Yuga Satya, Treta, Dvapara, Kali
- Each cycle of the 4 yugas is 4,320,000 years. (12,000 divine years)
- Kali Yuga, the fourth and present age, started in 3102 BCE
- 1000 cycles of these is 1 Kalpa
- A Kalpa is one Brahma day. And another one is Brahma night.
- Brahma 'lives' for 100 years and then the creation dissolves to be recreated.


